

He fell off the ladder into a ship's hold and died

A 47-year-old worker from a Koper died this afternoon in the port, in the hold of the Knossos ship. He climbed the ladder from the hold, and just before the summit he staggered and fell from a height of 17 meters.

KOPER> The news of the tragic work accident was reported in the afternoon by the Port of Koper. In an accident that happened around 4pm, an employee of an outside contractor company fatally crashed, explained Sebastjan Šik. "According to the information available so far, the worker fell into the ship's hold. The causes of the accident are being investigated by the police, who will be able to provide more detailed information. Luka Koper regrets the event and expresses its deepest condolences to the family," wrote Šik on behalf of the company.

As we learned, a 47-year-old worker from Koper died in the ship's hold and was employed by Gaf. The accident happened on the Knossos ship, which was on the eleventh berth in another pool. The ship brought the reels of cold-rolled sheet metal. In the afternoon, a group of workers waited in the ship's hold for a basket to lift them from the warehouse.

According to unofficial data, the 47-year-old worker reportedly opted to climb the ladder from the hold despite warnings. When he was just below the summit, he staggered (he may have slipped) and fell from a height of 17 meters. He suffered such severe injuries that they could no longer help him.

Police officers and criminals took a tour today, more information is expected to be released Thursday.
