

San Antonio: After accident, worker dies in container terminal

In the sector of new access to the port of San Antonio in the dependencies of the **company Deposits & Containers (D&C)**, a tragic accident occurred that ended the life of a worker of 57 years.

The background indicates that the operator was run over by a **container handling** machinery and was immediately taken to the Claudio Vicuña Hospital by SAMU personnel.

Unfortunately, after unsuccessful resuscitation, he would have died.

The company in a statement noted that:

"With deep pain, we report that today, during our normal operations, a collaboratoof our company suffered an accident resulting in death."

We have activated all the protocols, both human and those dictated by the Authority for this type of situation.

Due to the above, **our Terminal San Antonio will be closed, without operation,** while the corresponding investigations are carried out.

"We regret the inconvenience this may cause your operation, however we are facing a fact of <u>force majeure</u>. We are sure that we count on your usual support in this difficult moment »they pointed out from D&C.

We will expand according to new research background.
