



Port worker dies buried by soybeans in the Port of Santos

Accident occurred while worker was moving grain in the operational area of Warehouse 39

A port worker died buried by soybean meal in the operational area of Terminal XXXIX (39), operated by Caramuru, in Ponta da Praia.

The accident occurred at dawn this Tuesday (25th), in the private unit of the Santos pier. The Mobile Emergency Service (SAMU) attempted a rescue, but the victim could not resist the injuries.

As determined by [ATribuna.com.br](#), the accident occurred while the worker moved the grains in the port terminal. When activated, SAMU teams were sent to the scene, arrived to provide first aid and take the victim to the private Hospital Casa de Saude Santos in Embare. The worker did not resist the injuries and died in the medical complex.

The victim, who was a machine operator, had experience at the Santos pier. At the time of an accident, he was moving the soybean meal towards a spillway. It is a kind of load sucker.
