The Coast Guard is searching for a man who went missing after falling overboard in the Port of Savannah early Tuesday morning.

According to a press release, the Coast Guard Sector Charleston received notification at approximately 3 a.m., Tuesday from the Georgia Port Authority stating that a 70-yearold man fell off the vessel Maersk Tukang and did not resurface.

A MH-65 Dolphin helicopter aircrew from Air Station Savannah, 29-foot response boat from Station Tybee Island, crews from Department of Natural Resources, Savannah Fire and Rescue, Chatham County Sheriff's Office and Garden City Fire and Rescue are also involved in the search.
