

Dock worker killed in RTG accident in Port of Savannah

The Georgia Port Authority said in a statement that last Friday, an Ira dock worker died in a crane accident at the Savannah Garden City dock.

The coroner of Chatham County has identified the deceased as Stephen Cobb, 50 years old.

According to the "Government Procurement Agreement", the victim was seriously injured in a gantry crane rubber tire accident at about 6 am on March 26. He was pronounced dead on the spot.

Currently, under the leadership of the police department of the "Government Procurement Agreement", an investigation into the cause of the casualties is underway.

"The Georgia Port Authority wishes to express its condolences and concerns to the worker's family and his brothers and sisters in the International Longshoremen's Association," GPA wrote in a statement.
