

Man, 20, dies after being fatally injured at Dublin Port

GARDAI are investigating after a man in his 20s died at Dublin Port today.

According to reports he was fatally injured at a shipping premises at the port at around 3.30pm.

Emergency services were called to the scene and his body was removed to Dublin City Morgue where a post mortem examination will take place.

Gardai from Store Street station have carried out an examination of the scene and said enquiries are ongoing.

A spokesperson told the Irish Sun: "Gardaí in Store Street were alerted to a sudden death at a shipping premises at Dublin Port this afternoon, Saturday 15th May, 2021 at approximately 3.30p.m.

"The man, 20 years was fatally injured at a workplace accident and Gardaí and Emergency services were called to the scene.
