

Work, a young docker dies

Matteo Leone didn't make it. He died during the night, at the Salerno hospital, the worker who, in the early afternoon of yesterday, May 25, was injured in an accident at the port. The injuries sustained by the thirty four-year-old worker of the port company, well known in the city, were too serious.

The causes of the accident are to be clarified, but according to an initial reconstruction, Matteo Leone was hit by an operating machine, probably an industrial truck. The investigations are entrusted to the border police and the port authorities.

The regional and provincial secretariats of Filt Cgil, Fit Cisl and Ultrasporti, since two o'clock last night, have called a 24-hour strike for the workers of the port of Salerno. "It is unacceptable - they comment - that a young person could die while doing his duty, because work does not have to mean death". The trade unions show "all their solidarity and closeness to the family and to all port workers. Safety in the workplace is a fundamental and inalienable right".

Many messages of condolence appeared on social media to remember Matteo.
