

Santa Marta | Head of Operations of the Port Society died in a work accident

In a tragic workplace accident that occurred on Thursday night, inside the Santa Marta Port Society, the company's chief operating officer died.

The victim was identified as Gari Sandoval Pérez, 47 years old, he was a Business Administration professional with an emphasis on Finance and Systems, a specialist in Logistics, a native of Santa Marta, he was married and the father of two children. According to the report of what happened, Sandoval Pérez died instantly when one of the tires of a heavy vehicle exploded, causing him a severe blow to the head.

Until the day of his death, the victim was studying the International Master in Maritime and Port Administration, he was an employee of the Puerto de Santa Marta company since July 16, 1997, where he entered as a Storage Assistant with opportunities to promote and for Hence he reached the position of Chief of Operations and Vice President of Operations in charge.

Through a statement, the Puerto de Santa Marta company expressed their condolences for what happened to the worker, highlighting their excellent work offered for 24 years, they also expressed their unconditional support with each of their relatives who are going through this terrible loss.
