The Chief of Operations of the Port of Santa Marta dies in an occupational accident

A work accident ended the life, in the last hours, of Garivaldi Sandoval Pérez, who was the Chief of Operations of the Port of Santa Marta.

Sandoval Pérez, 47, died after an apparently heavy vehicle tire exploded and he received a severe impact to the head.

Through a statement, the Port of Santa Marta regretted what happened to its worker, while recalling that he had started working on July 16, 1997 as a storage assistant, but his qualities led him to improve himself and that is why he was currently working as Head of Operations and Vice President of Operations in charge.

The deceased was a business administrator with an emphasis on finance and systems; specialist in logistics and currently studying an international master's degree in maritime and port administration.
