

Piraeus / Tragic work accident at Cosco pier

A worker was fatally hit by a bridge crane at pier 2 of the Container Terminal of Piraeus - 24-hour strike of the workers from today at 00:00

A40-year-old worker died **tragically** at pier 2 at the Piraeus Container Station, when, under unclear circumstances, he was fatally hit by a bridge crane.

He was reportedly **trapped on the rails** of the crane, resulting in fatal injuries. After the accident, he was taken to a hospital in Nice, where he was pronounced dead.

Among his colleagues, **anger** and **rage** over the new **work accident** at Cosco piers are overflowing.

The employees, following a proposal by the Board of Directors of the ENEDEP Association, stopped their work at the port and gathered in front of the gate of SEMPO. "They can no longer play with the lives of workers to increase their profits," said the president of ENEDEP, Markos Bekris.

At the same time, as 902.gr broadcasts, the employees, with a decision of the extraordinary General Assembly of the ENEDEP Association, are going on a **24-hour strike** from **today at 00:00 until 12 midnight on Tuesday**.
