## A stevedore is crushed by a forklift in the Port of Valencia

The works council of the Valencia Port Center of Employment terminates its activity for several hours due to the work accident

A 45-year-old stevedore died this afternoon in a work-related accident at the South Pier of the <u>Port of Valencia</u>. Alberto Aguado was crushed by a lifting machine that overturned at the facilities of the **Terminal Marítima de** Graneles (Temagra) company.

After receiving the notice of the accident at 3:00 p.m., a Police patrol and an ambulance from the Valencia Port Authority rushed to the scene, but the worker had already died when the medical team arrived.

The stevedores of the three terminals (MSC-TV, CSPV, APM) left their jobs to go to a meeting point after the works council of **the Port Center of Employment (CPE) of Valencia** decided to terminate the work activity for 20 hours. The Valencia Port Authority has already contacted the victim's colleagues and unions to show their support and condolences.
