Suao port "1.1 ton cargo bag suddenly dropped" worker was crushed and deformed to death

A 59-year-old man surnamed Chen was assisting the stacking of 1.1-ton chemical raw material "paraxylene" space bags in the hold of a cargo ship in Suao Port on the 8th. It is suspected that the ship's hull shook and the upper space bags fell. His head was deformed, and he died after being sent to the hospital.

A cargo ship berthing at Pier 7 of Suao Port was loaded with about 9,000 bags of chemical raw material "paraxylene", each about 1 meter high and weighing 1.1 metric tons, at 7 o'clock on the evening of the 8th. A 59-year-old man surnamed

Chen and other 3 or 4 personnel assisted in the stacking operation. It was suspected that the ship swayed and the super bag stacked on the upper layer fell. Chen Nan could not dodge and was crushed. The personnel on the side immediately notified the relevant units for rescue.

The Suao Port Fire Brigade received a notification at 7:58 p.m. on the 8th and immediately dispatched people and vehicles to rescue. When the ambulance personnel arrived, they found that Chen Nan's head had been deformed and had lost signs of life, and he was immediately sent to Taipei Veterans General Hospital Su. The Australian branch was still unable to recover after first aid, and the body was then transported to Luodong Shouyuan; the prosecutor met yesterday afternoon and convened an investigation court to understand the process of the incident.

Chen Guodong, senior director of the Suao Port Operations Office of the Keelung Port Branch, told a reporter from the Central News Agency today that the family of the deceased was coordinating with the loading and unloading company for reconciliation. The cargo ship loading operation will resume at 1 pm today.
