The victim Massimo De Vita, a former employee of the Taranto Container Terminal company, was 45 years old. He was in charge of handling the wind turbines, on the fourth projecting, west side. According to an initial reconstruction, he would have been crushed by the blades after the overturning of the iron frame that contained them. De Vita had been assigned by the Tct company, which left the Taranto container terminal for years, to the port company as part of the interventions for the re-employment of port personnel. Police forces and the Port Authority of Taranto intervened on the spot.

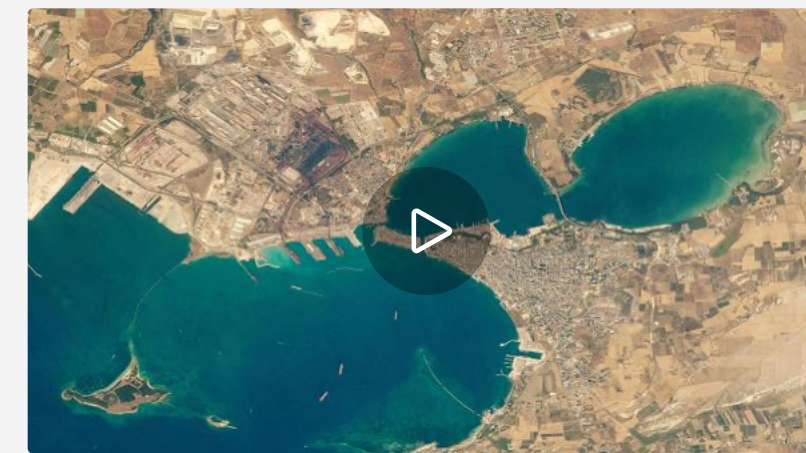
