

Callao: Driver loses control of his truck and dies when falling into the sea

Nothing and no one could save him! On April 20, a driver identified as Julio César Quiroz Ormeño, 74 years old, lost control of his truck, got confused and ended up falling into the sea of Callao. The unfortunate event occurred at night in front of one of the north piers of the Multipurpose Terminal.

Witnesses to the accident alerted the National Police of Peru, exactly from the Salvage Unit, who immediately arrived at the scene and after hard work managed to recover the body. So far it is known that the heavy cargo unit is still submerged in the middle of the waters of the First Port.

For its part, the company TL Transler, where the deceased had been working for many years, did not hesitate to speak out through a statement. "With much regret, we regret to inform you of the occurrence of the accident in the port of Callao. This produced the sensitive death of our collaborator Julio César Quiroz Ormeño".

"Our company has continuously reported and coordinated with the authorities the investigation of the event, in order to determine the causes. In this context, we reiterate our condolences to the families and express our solidarity with them. Likewise, we ratify our total disposition in the respective proceedings," they added.

It is worth mentioning that the remains were taken to the Callao Morgue, where the family will have to go to identify the body. Meanwhile, the family man's friends remembered him as a hardworking man who had been driving for years and had not had any problems to date.
