Porto Marghera, the worker who fell from the container died. Brugnaro: "Unacceptable tragedy"

33-year-old Alessandro Zabeo, who had worked as a temporary worker for 14 years, died after ending up in a coma. Day of mourning at the port, where the workers are on strike.

Venice, 24 May 2022 - 33-year-old Alessandro Zabeo, the young worker who <u>crashed</u> <u>yesterday in Porto Marghera</u>, couldn't make it through the night. The man had fallen from a height of three meters into a ship managed by Vecon - the company that manages the terminal - after a life as a precarious: he had worked as a **temporary worker for 14 years**.

The 33-year-old hit his head and **went into a coma**, only to expire late yesterday evening. The causes of the fall from one of the ship's containers are still being examined. Among the hypotheses, that of an **illness** makes its way, but the worker could also have **leaned excessively** from the protected paths. At 6.30 today, a **union presidium** of Filt Cgil, Filt Cisl and Uiltrasporti was activated in the headquarters of the port workers' company, with consequent **blocking of activities for the whole day**.
