

Venice, accident at work in Porto Marghera: 34-year-old worker dies

Alessandro Zabeo was in charge of securing the Porto Marghera containers. Yesterday he fell from a small elevation of about three meters, hitting his head and then being hospitalized in a coma

Alessandro Zebeo, the 34-year-old worker who fell while working inside a ship in the Vecon container terminal in Porto Marghera, in the province of Venice, did not make it.

The man died in the evening, as reported by the port unions of the city. Zebeo was in charge of lashing the containers and, according to an initial reconstruction, yesterday he fell from a elevation of about three meters, hitting his head and then being hospitalized in a coma at the All'Angelo hospital in Mestre.

The circumstances that caused the fall have yet to be clarified, a fact on which the investigation of the case is being carried out. The worker may have leaned too far from the foreseen protected paths but among the hypotheses there is also that of an illness.
