Worker died after falling from a height in the port of Antofagasta

The Antofagasta International Terminal (ATI) confirmed the unfortunate news about the death that occurred during the early hours of this Wednesday during its work.

Through a statement, the Antofagasta International Terminal (ATI) confirmed the death of a worker, who would have lost his life after falling from a height during the early hours of this Wednesday.

"This morning, for reasons that are being investigated, one of the workers at Antofagasta International Terminal (ATI), identified as Dublin Zambrana Toledo, lost his life when he fell from a height," they explain in the document.

And they add, "immediately the protocols were activated to provide him with medical assistance, however he died on the spot". They detail that the 37-year-old official worked three years ago in the company, they also point out "at the time of the accident he was carrying out maintenance work."

For his part, the general manager of ATI, Juan Pablo Santibáñez, states "this is a day of mourning for our entire team, we are shocked. We deeply regret this accident and have already launched an investigation to determine its causes and take the necessary actions. ".

Finally, they say "the company is in contact with the worker's family to provide all the necessary support and psychological support will also be provided for team members who require it."
