



Death of a port worker alters the start of the cruise season in Valparaíso

The death of a port worker at **Terminal Portuario Valparaíso (TPV)** forced the start of the 2022-2023 cruise season to be altered.

The first scheduled stopover was that of the ship MS Fram, which had to arrive at the TPV at 11:00 this Sunday. However, as a result of this fatal accident, the ship was inserted into the planning of Terminal Pacífico Sur, concessionaire of Terminal 1.

"Due to the unfortunate death of a Terminal 2 worker, we inform that the activity was suspended due to the arrival of the first passenger ship of this season, scheduled for 11 am today at our terminal," said the Valparaíso Port Company.

"From now on, Empresa Portuaria Valparaíso expresses its regret over this situation and commits its permanent willingness to collaborate with the concessionaire and with the authorities in whatever is necessary," added the state company.

From the concessionaire of Terminal 2 of the Port of Valparaíso they regretted what happened. "It is with great regret that we must report the occurrence of an accident that took place this morning at our terminal, which resulted in the death of a port worker."

"As a result of this situation, the protocols for medical assistance and detention of tasks were immediately activated to provide all the necessary attention to the worker, also delivering all the information to the corresponding authorities," added the concessionaire.

"We deeply regret this accident that mourns our community and all those who work at Terminal 2 in Valparaíso. The corresponding investigations have been initiated to determine the causes of this fact and adopt the necessary measures. As a concessionaire of Terminal 2, we contacted the worker's family in order to express our regret and provide all the help that is necessary to face this moment", concluded TPV.
