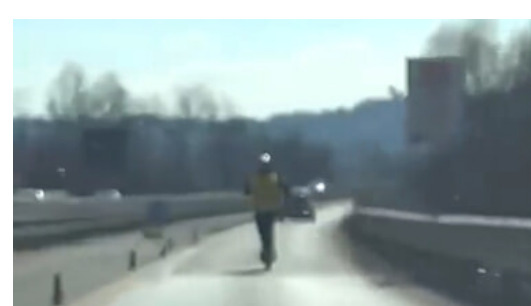

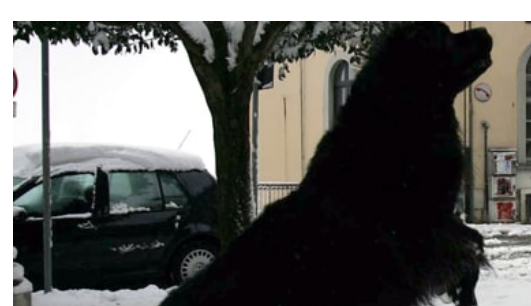

# Tragedy at the port, he falls with the forklift into the sea and dies

Paolo Borselli was working at the port of Trieste but lost control of his forklift falling into the water: another death at work

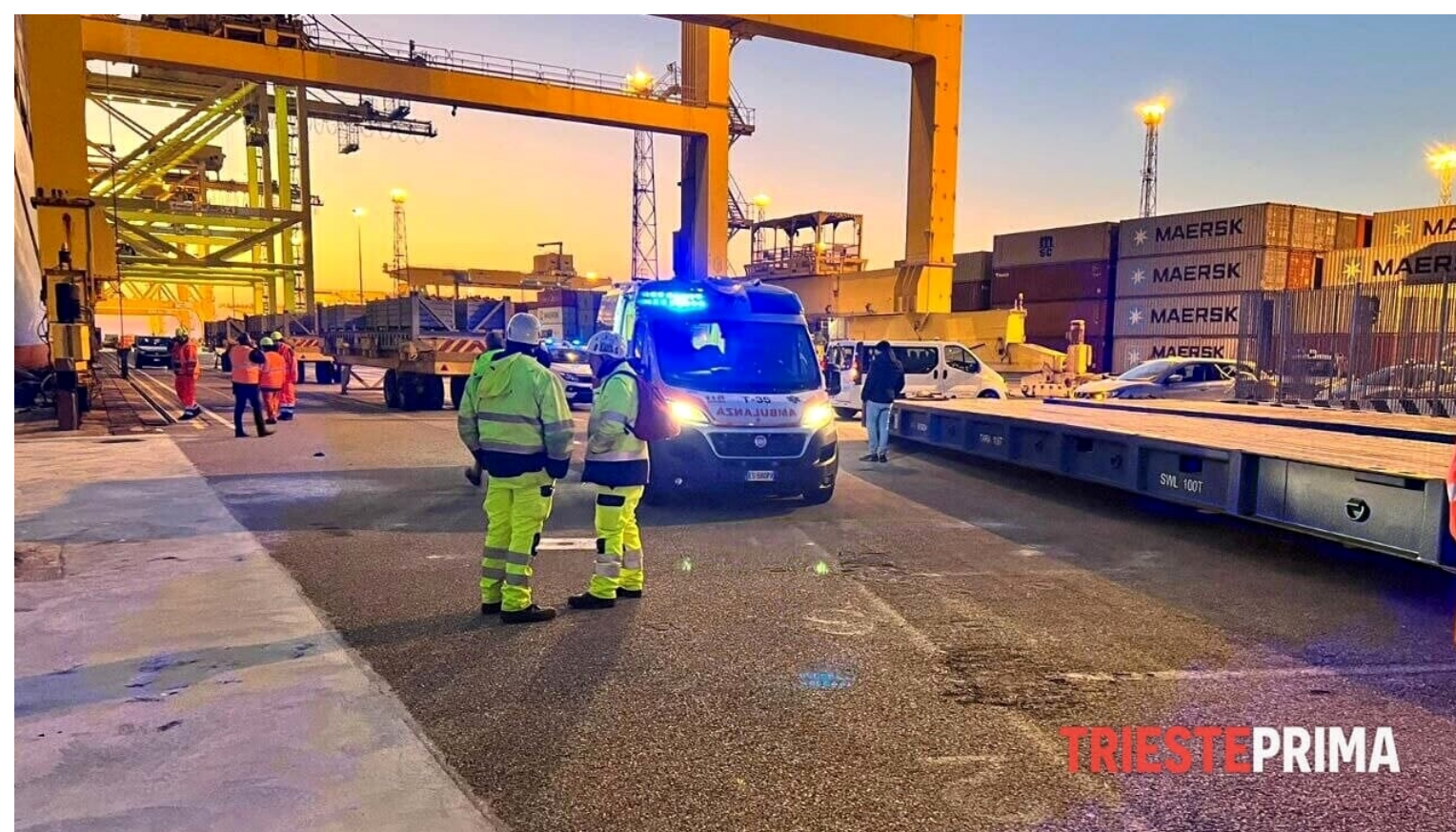

A 58-year-old worker, Paolo Borselli was found dead in the waters inside the port of Trieste. According to reports from TriestePrima, the man was driving a forklift but lost control and ended up in the water. The accident happened in the early afternoon, but the body was only found around 5 pm. On the spot, divers from the fire brigade, the harbor master's office, the maritime police and the 118 health workers who could only ascertain the death. Following the tragedy, the unions proclaimed an immediate strike until 7pm tomorrow, Friday 10 February.

"I am deeply shaken by this tragedy. On my own behalf and on behalf of the entire port community, I express our closeness and participation in the pain to Paolo Borselli's family. I can only confirm that we will continue to operate and invest so that similar terrible episodes never happen again". This is the message of condolence from Zeno D'Agostino, president of the Port System Authority of the Eastern Adriatic Sea. "We have placed the issue of work, and safety in the workplace, at the center of our mandate and right from the start as many concrete acts and many projects testify. I have no words - he concludes - to express the frustration and bewilderment in the face of death di Borselli, who asks us and indeed expects us to continue to commit ourselves for the future".
