

A 62-year-old man dies in a work accident at the port

Louis Langel died on Saturday April 15 at the port of Galisbay, after being the victim of a work accident. The president of the Collectivity Louis Mussington sent his condolences.

Around 9:30 p.m. on Saturday April 15, Louis Langel lost his life while unloading a barge containing sand at the port of Galisbay. According to our information, the 62-year-old man was at the controls of a mechanical shovel when the accident occurred. An investigation is underway to determine the circumstances of this tragedy.

The day after the accident, the president of the Collectivity Louis Mussington sent a message of condolence. "I learned with great sadness of the death of Mr. Louis Langel during a handling operation on board a barge anchored at the port of Galisbay, Saturday evening," said the president. He was very involved in associations, especially softball, and as such was very popular in the sports world", said the president of the Collectivity, Louis Mussington.

The chairman of the board of directors of the port of Galisbay, my elected colleague Daniel Arnel, the director of the port Alberic Ellis and his staff, as well as the elected representatives of the territorial council of Saint-Martin join me in expressing our heartfelt condolences and our unwavering support to the family as they face this painful ordeal.
