The worker fell into the river from the rail of a ship that was being loaded. His companions retrieved him but he had already passed away. The union went on strike to demand better job safety conditions.

A port worker died this Friday morning when he fell into the river in a work accident during loading tasks on a ship.

The tragedy occurred when the operator lost his balance on the platform he was on and fell from a considerable height into the river.

The worker's colleagues who witnessed the fall went to help to rescue him from the water, but when they managed to get him out, the 60-year-old man was already dead.

The accident occurred around 4:30 p.m. on Friday.

Faced with this situation, the Single Union of Argentine Ports (Supa) ordered a total stoppage of activities to demand security measures. A spokesman denounced that at the dock "there was no ambulance, and the partner did not have life jackets. We always work in the same way, there are no conditions" he told the press.
