

The Puerto de Rosario stopped again

Stevedores denounce that the company failed to comply with the conciliation agreement and they stopped work again.

Stevedores stopped again late this Tuesday afternoon at the port of Rosario, denouncing that the company failed to comply with the conditions agreed in the mandatory conciliation.

"Deliberately, despite everything discussed in the hearing held before this Ministry and despite the very serious event that occurred last Friday that cost the life of a colleague, the company persists in its intention to impose on the stevedores that they continue working, without adopting the basic and essential measures to guarantee their safety and health", expresses the union complaint.

The text maintains that "the State, as an oversight body and guardian of law enforcement, cannot consent that the negligence of a company and its lack of investment put the lives of the people who work for it at risk" and in that In this sense, it demands that "Terminal Puerto Rosario should not be allowed or tolerated to continue with its constant breaches of all kinds."

Added to the claim of the stevedores union, which decreed an indefinite strike, is the uneasiness of the carriers due to the delays in unloading as a result of the strike.
