

Japan: Container crushes worker at Yokohama Port dock

A port worker died after a container fell from a crane onto a truck at the **Honmoku** Pier in **the Port of Yokohama**, Japan.

As Shine indicates, the container, approximately 10 meters long, was being loaded into the truck when it fell near the driver's cabin.

After the incident, the city's firefighters carried out rescue work to find the 73-year-old man, who was transferred to a local hospital in cardiorespiratory arrest.

Likewise, the Police are carrying out an investigation to find the reasons for the fall of the container, it should be noted that they do not rule out the possibility of professional negligence.

With respect to the Honmoku dock, it handles almost 50% of the container traffic of the port area.
