Woman seriously injured when pallet falls on her at JaxPort's Blount Island terminal

A woman working in the SSA Cooper paper warehouse at 5050 Propeller Way at the Blount Island marine terminal was seriously injured Tuesday when a pallet fell on her, according to the Jacksonville Sheriff’s Office.

The woman, who has not been identified, was pinned to the ground when a pallet of paper collapsed about 8:50 a.m. City paramedics transported her to a hospital with what were

described as life-threatening injuries, but no more information is available on the cause of the accident.

The U.S. Occupational Safety and Health Administration has been notified and will conduct a separate investigation, the Sheriff’s Office said.

According to the SSA Cooper website, the company handles stevedoring services in Wilmington and Morehead City, N.C.; Charleston and Georgetown, S.C.; Savannah and Brunswick, Ga.; and Jacksonville.

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
