

Truck driver struck, killed at Georgia Ports Authority terminal

According to officials at the Georgia Ports Authority, a truck driver was killed in a wreck at Savannah's Garden City Terminal Tuesday morning.

Officials say that according to preliminary reports, the driver had exited his truck when he was struck by another truck.

This reportedly happened on the Mason rail yard at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday.

WJCL reached out to the company where the victim was employed. One of the owners tells us they're devastated because their colleague was a wonderful person and driver.

Emergency crews said the victim died on scene. The incident is being investigated by Georgia Ports Authority Police.
