

Port worker died in San Antonio after being hit by a truck

The PDI investigates the causes of the event.

Authorities initiated summary proceedings to determine responsibilities.



José Ramón Ulloa Plaza, 54, died inside the Claudio Vicuña hospital.

A serious accident **cost the life of a security guard from** the Huelén company who performed functions in the "**Logistic Node**" sector **of the port of San Antonio**, when it was **run over by one of the trucks** carrying port cargo to the terminal.

According to the information obtained by Carabineros and given to the inspection bodies, the worker " was directing the transit of trucks, at which time it is passed to be carried and run over by one of them ", according to the Seremi del Trabajo de Valparaíso, María Violeta Silva.

The authority added that "there are the oversight bodies, the Health Secretariat making the health summary and the Labor Office will proceed to **review whether or not there are administrative sanctions**."

That is, "whether or not the labor regulations were complied with in the employment contract, if they were aware of the internal regulations, whether they had the elements of personal protection or not, in order to determine what are the causes of the accident. ", detailed the authority.

The worker identified as José Ramón Ulloa Plaza, 54, **died inside the Claudio Vicuña hospital** in San Antonio.

By instruction of the local prosecutor's office, the investigation of this accident was the responsibility of the PDI .
