

One of the crew killed in an accident in the port was a foreigner

The Port Society issued a statement in which it gave details about what happened and regretted what happened.

The fateful accident, which occurred on Saturday night in the Port of Santa Marta, left two people dead; a foreigner and another samarium, who belonged to the Carbosan company.

The foreigner of Myanmar (Southeast Asia) was identified as Aung Myo Thet, who was a crew member of the Suzaku Motonave.

The man of Asian origin died at the scene of the accident, the body was rescued by divers.

The second victim corresponds to the name of Nicolás Enrique Carbonó López, who worked as operator 1 of Carbosan.

"In a quick action of our support team, we managed to provide first aid, but unfortunately died at the Clinic of Prado for cardiorespiratory arrest," said Puerto de Santa Marta in the statement.

The facts

The accident was recorded at 8:52 p.m. on Pier 7, when a berthing operation was carried out on a coal ship.

According to witnesses, three people fell into the water and presumably the two deceased fell on the ladder they used to get on the ship, fortunately the third involved was unharmed.

Puerto de Santa Marta in his letter said that it is providing the necessary information and support to the authorities in order to collaborate in the relevant investigations.

"The Puerto de Santa Marta family expresses its sadness and deeply regrets what happened with these two human losses," the company said in the document.
