

Fabio Correale's death: Investigated for manslaughter

The Prosecutor's Office has launched an unknown investigation, for manslaughter, for the death of Fabio Correale, the 37-year-old worker who died on Sunday, November 10 in the hold of a ship in the port of Crotone. The investigation, entrusted to the Port Authority, will have to clarify the causes of death, which no longer seem to be attributable to an illness, as initially thought.

According to the first results of the autopsy, in fact, elements would have emerged that would exclude the hypothesis of a natural cause, even if no other news has leaked on this aspect. Several tracks are currently under examination by the Port Authority, although gas poisoning seems unlikely.

To fully understand the causes of Correale's death, it will be necessary to wait for the complete outcome of the autopsy tests, which will be sent to the Prosecutor's Office within 60 days. Meanwhile, yesterday Correale's funeral took place in the church of San Paolo a Tufolo.
