



Port worker dies after accident in the Port of Santos

Man was struck by cargo during the accident

The port worker Cláudio Robert do Nascimento Nusa, 49, died after an accident in the hold of the *Aegean Spirit* ship, flagged by the Marshall Islands, and which was docked at the **Port of Santos**. He had 17 years of experience as a stevedor and worked for the Ecoporto company.

The accident occurred around 3:30 pm on Thursday (2), while Cláudio was operating in the shipment of eucatex ties. The cargo pressed the worker, who fell into the hold of the ship.

The Secretariat of Public Security of São Paulo (SSP-SP) reported that the worker was removed by a private emergency team. The group tried to resuscitate him with cardiopulmonary resuscitation maneuvers.

The Fire Department sent 17 professionals to the place, but the victim was already being rescued. Cláudio was referred to the Mobile Emergency Service (Samu) and taken to the Central UPA of Santos.

Unfortunately, he couldn't resist the injuries and died shortly after. The Brazilian Navy, through the Port Authority of São Paulo (CPSP), was notified and sent experts to the site.

The CPSP established an Administrative Inquiry to investigate the accident. The Navy also expressed its condolences to Cláudio Nusa's family members.

The case was registered as a suspected death in the 2^o Police District of Santos. The investigation was forwarded to the 1^o DP, which investigates the area of the accident. Expert examinations were requested from the Institute of Criminalistics (IC) and the Forensic Medical Institute (IML). The investigation aims to investigate the causes of the tragedy that took Cláudio's life.
