Kaohsiung Port Gongan Accident: A 27-year-old worker was hit by a hoisting cable and seriously injured

On the afternoon of the 8th, a work safety accident occurred at Pier 39 in Kaohsiung Port. A 27-year-old worker surnamed Li was suspected of being hit by a crane cable used for loading and unloading goods. Li Nan was seriously injured in his head and back, and lost signs of his life on the spot. He was lifted from the bottom of the ship's hold, but he was still declared unconscious when he was sent to the hospital. A 27-year-old worker surnamed Li was hit by a lifting cable for loading and unloading goods while working at Pier 39 in Kaohsiung Port this afternoon.

Li Nan was seriously injured in the head and other places, and he lost signs of his life on the spot. He was still unconscious at about 2:50 p.m., and the exact cause of the accident is yet to be clarified.

After the incident was reported, 3 emergency vehicles and 6 responders were sent to the site. At 1:49 p.m. Li Nan was lifted from the bottom of the ship's hold and sent to the hospital for treatment.

Zeng Wenrui, the captain of the second port squad of the Kaohsiung Port Brigade, said that when Li Nan, a Taiwanese native, was working at Pier 39 of Kaohsiung Port at about 1:30 p.m. He was suspected of being hit by a cable used for loading and unloading goods, causing Li Nan's head and back to be seriously injured and showing cardiac and pulmonary function arrest in front of the hospital (OHCA).

The Second Port Squad of the Kaohsiung Port Team said that Li Nan was urgently sent to Ruan General Hospital for rescue, but due to his serious injury he was still declared unconscious at 2:50 p.m. (Editor: Chen Renhua)
