

Flash News/Kaohsiung Port worker hit by a cable. Lifted from the bottom of the ship's hold and died of blood loss.



Kaohsiung Port reported a death accident! At about 1 p.m. today (1/8), a 28-year-old man surnamed Li was working at the bottom of the Savita ship at Pier 39 in Kaohsiung Port. He was hit by a hanging cable and fell to the ground on the spot. His face, hand and back were bleeding due to the heavy blow, and he had no breathing and heartbeat on the spot. He was retrieved and sent to the hospital by the on-site personnel's CPR, but it was still at 2:56. The statement is incurable, and the detailed cause of the accident is still to be clarified by the relevant units.

At about 1 p.m. today, the Kaohsiung Port Brigade received a notification that a man was hit by a suspended cable in the bottom of the Savita ship at Pier 39 of the former town. The second port team of the Kaohsiung Port Brigade went to the rescue. A total of 3 vehicles and 6 people were dispatched and the man was evacuated at 13:49, but he no longer had signs of life,
