

Montevideo port worker dies after falling on railing of perimeter fence in front of warehouse

The National Navy reported that the worker was from Bomport. The Prosecutor's Office ordered forensic examination, witness statements and the statement of the person responsible for the property.

A worker at the port of Montevideo died in the early hours of this Saturday after falling on the rail that served as a perimeter fence in the warehouse area, the National Navy reported. According to the report, at about 4:00 a.m. an emergency call came in from Montecon reporting that a person had been injured in front of warehouse number 20. The victim was identified as a worker from the Bomport company, the Navy said.

When the victim was leaving work with other colleagues, they avoided the pedestrian path to shorten the route and he died when he fell on a rail that served as a perimeter fence.

The Ambulance of the Medical Service of the National Port Administration (ANP) confirmed the death and the acting prosecutor ordered that a forensic examination be carried out and that statements be taken from witnesses and the person responsible for the perimeter fence.

The body is currently in the judicial morgue and the prosecutor's final order has yet to be fulfilled.
