

## Worker dies in work accident in port of the PSA company

The Mitradel and the Maritime Authority make the corresponding investigations

The Ministry of Labor and Labor Development (Mitradel), reported a work accident that occurred in the port of the Panama International Terminal (PSA), in the area of the south dock. One worker died and another has injuries.

Both employees belong to the company Talleres Industriales de Panamá.

The institution regrets the incident and investigates the causes through the National Inspection Directorate.

Mitradel inspectors went to the port to carry out an investigation in order to clarify the circumstances of the incident.

According to the entity, during the intervention, it was sought to ensure that the process progressed with transparency and take the necessary measures to prevent similar situations in the future.

It should be noted that the port has its own team of safety officers, who also play a role in the supervision of activities and safety on site.

Mitradel calls on employers and workers to take the appropriate corrective actions, in order to avoid sanctions and above all, reduce occupational risks.

The entity not only has the function of supervising, but also of guiding companies on compliance with current labor regulations.

The Maritime Authority of Panama in collaboration with the port concessionaire company has initiated an internal investigation to clarify the causes of the labor incident
