Who is Vincenzo Giova, the Neapolitan port worker who died in an accident at work in Catania

Vincenzo Giova, 52, died in Catania during the loading and unloading operations of a eurocargo. Union anger: "Dead to make a living"

Yet another victim of an accident at work is a 52-year-old Neapolitan worker: Vincenzo Giova, father of four children, died in the port of Catania last night. He had embarked on a Eurocargo vessel of the Grimaldi group, which was supposed to set sail in the direction of Salerno. The incident would have occurred during the loading and unloading phases in the port of the Etna capital: on the spot, in addition to the 118 personnel who could do nothing but verify the death, also the border police agents and soldiers of the Coast Guard.

The Catania Prosecutor's Office, with the added prosecutor Agata Santonocito and the substitute Lina Trovato, has opened an investigation file: in the register of the suspects is a 60-year-old Catania maneuverer was registered, a hypothesis of the crime of manslaughter; for the moment, lawyer Luca Blasi clarified, it is an "act due to guarantee the suspect", in view of any unrepeatable investigations to ascertain the dynamics.

Seized the area to carry out the relevant surveys. This is an area of the port where only ferries and containers are embarked: the Grimaldi company has expressed its solidarity and closeness to the victim's family, who had worked as a seafarer for years. The CGIL and the CISL, the Filt Cgil and the Fit Cisl of Catania, we read in a note, declare themselves "saddened and angry" because once again "a worker lost his life while earning a living. Giova, father of four children, from Campania, worked for years in the maritime sector and never returned home leaving his family and all the people who loved him in pain".
