

Fatal accident in the port of Moín: longshoreman falls into the sea during loading maneuvers

The man was hit in the chest by cargo being loaded and then fell into the sea

A longshoreman from the Servinave company died on Saturday night while carrying out port work at the Gastón Kogan terminal in Moín, in Limón. The victim was identified as **José Guerrero Castillo**.

According to the Port Administration and Economic Development Board of the Atlantic Vertiente (JAPDEVA), **Guerrero was carrying out maneuvers of loading rods when**, apparently, due to the movement of the ship, one of the ties hit him on the chest and, when trying to hold on to it, he fell into the sea.

"We extend our most sincere solidarity to the grieving family, as well as to their fellow port workers, who today face an irreparable loss. **We recognize the value and commitment of each port worker**, whose daily work sustains the economic movement of the country," Japdeva said through a press release.

The Judicial Investigation Agency (OIJ) took over the investigations of the case to clarify the circumstances of the accident.
