

## Port worker dies in Limón after accident during ship loading operations

The unfortunate incident occurred while loading the ship with steel rods.

A tragedy shook the port of Limón in the early hours of Saturday, after the longed by the last name Guerrero Castillo, a collaborator of the Servinave company, lost his life during loading work, as confirmed in an official statement by the Board of Port Administration and Economic Development of the Atlantic Slope (JAPDEVA).

The unfortunate incident occurred while loading maneuvers with rods were being carried out. According to preliminary reports, one of the bundled rods hit the worker hard on the chest

due to the movement of the ship. Guerrero tried to hold on to it but fell into the sea. The exact circumstances of the event are being investigated by the competent authorities.

From JAPDEVA, the executive president, MBA. Sacy Wing Ching, expressed his deep solidarity with the grieving family, as well as with the fellow port workers who today face this irreparable loss.

***"We recognize the value and commitment of each port worker, whose daily work sustains the economic movement of the country,"*** says the statement.

In addition, the institution reiterated its commitment to operational safety and the well-being of all workers in the port sector, ensuring that they will remain attentive to the development of the investigation.
