



Forklift Operator Questioned for Work Accident at Smart Warehouse, KBN Marunda

JAKARTA - The Criminal Investigation Unit of the Cilincing Police has investigated the death of a man with the initials GH (43) who was run over by a [forklift](#) type heavy equipment at the Smart Warehouse, KBN Marunda, Cilincing District, North Jakarta.

"Two witnesses with initials AW and AA were examined regarding the accident," said Cilincing Police Chief, AKP Bobi Subasri when confirmed, Friday, February 27, afternoon.

Based on the testimony of the witness AW, he learned about the incident after seeing the side loader pass by and it looked like there was an object hit by the side loader.

Then this witness immediately informed through walkie-talkie. Hearing the news conveyed by AW, then AA immediately saw the object.

When seen by AW, it turned out that the object was the victim with the body lying on its stomach with the body in a crushed condition. AW then informed the management about the incident.

"From the results of CCTV footage at the scene, it can be seen that the victim was walking towards the electrical substation. Then from behind the side loader driven by the reported came and ran over the victim," he said.

From the confession of the reported AS (36), he admitted that he did not see any victims walking.

"The reporter found out about this after being reprimanded by witness 1 through walkie-talkie," he said.

After an investigation, the Cilincing Police Criminal Investigation Unit named one person with the initials AS (36) as the reported in the fatal incident.

AS is an operator of a side loader heavy equipment that ran over the victim.
